


OUT OF BALANCE LOAD

- During a spin, the message shown to the right may be displayed.
- This is a normal message when the washer is attempting to better distribute an out of balance clothes load before accelerating to the full spin speed. You do not need to stop the cycle or reset the washer.
- The washer will slow back down, re-tumble the clothes and then attempt to reach the full spin speed again.
- In any wash stage that isn't the final rinse, the washer will attempt to spin, redistribute if it is out of balance, and then attempt the spin a second time. If the second attempt is also out of balance, the washer will progress to the next stage in the wash cycle.
- During the final rinse stage, the washer will attempt to spin, redistribute if it is out of balance, and then attempt to spin again. If still out of balance, redistribution attempts will be repeated. If the clothes load is still out of balance after a fourth try, it will stop attempting to go into spin and will agitate for the remainder of the cycle time and the cycle will end.

OUT OF BALANCE LOAD

The current load is unbalanced and preventing the machine from reaching full spin speed.







EXCESSIVE VIBRATION

 If a clothes load is excessively out of balance, the maximum displacement switch could be tripped during operation due to excessive tub movement. This screen indicates that the switch has been tripped and that the washer will need to be reset:


Door will unlock once cylinder stops moving. Inspect machine for installation issues. To clear, reset Excessive Vibration in General Settings of the Management Section.





 To reset the washer, first pull out the black plunger on the switch which is located behind the front panel on the left side of the washer tub. You can access this switch in three ways.





- Then follow the instructions on the display to reset the washer.
- Enter the management section by pressing the green start button. Enter the 4-digit management passcode using the arrow keys to change the number and the start button to select each number. After entering the 4 digits, press start to confirm:












 Scroll down using the arrow button to "General Settings" then press the start button:








 Scroll down using the arrow button to "Excessive Vibration" then press the start button:









 Press the down arrow button to change from "Reset" to "Ready", then press the start button:









• (1) Press the red stop button to exit this screen. Press the red stop button a second time until the screen below appears. (2) Press the down arrow to change from "Cancel" to "Confirm" and (3) then press the green start button to confirm and save the change:








• Press stop button to exit this screen. Continue to press the stop button until you have returned to the Ready screen:

 The washer may display the red Excessive Vibration screen a second time. If so, please repeat the previous steps on the screen to reset the washer. You will not need to physically reset the plunger on the switch a second time.
