



WC-Series Vended Washers Preventative Maintenance

Preventative Maintenance

Daily

- **Step 1:** Clean the top and the cabinet to remove residue.
- **Step 2:** Clean the soap dispenser and soap lid
- **Step 3:** Check the drain for leaking and proper draining.
- **Step 4:** Check the loading door for leaks.
- **Step 5:** Clean the door seal of all foreign material.
- **Step 6:** Leave the loading door open to aerate the washer when not in use.

Monthly

Step 1: Clean with dry and clean compressed air through optical coin acceptor to remove dust and lint.

Quarterly

Make sure the power is disconnected before making the following checks.

- **Step 1:** Check the drive belt for wear and proper tension.
- **Step 2:** Clean lint and other foreign material from around drive motor.
- **Step 3:** Check all water connections for leaks.
- **Step 4:** Wipe and clean the inside of the washer and check all electrical components for moisture and dust.
- **Step 5:** Remove and clean water inlet hose filters. Replace if necessary.
- Step 6: After any service always replace all panels before reconnecting electrical power.

Biannually

Step 1: Clean the fan on the bottom of the VFD with dry and clean compressed air.

Annually

- **Step 1:** Inspect all wire connections for tightness
- **Step 2:** Inspect and check the tightness of the mounting bolts securing the washer to base frame.
